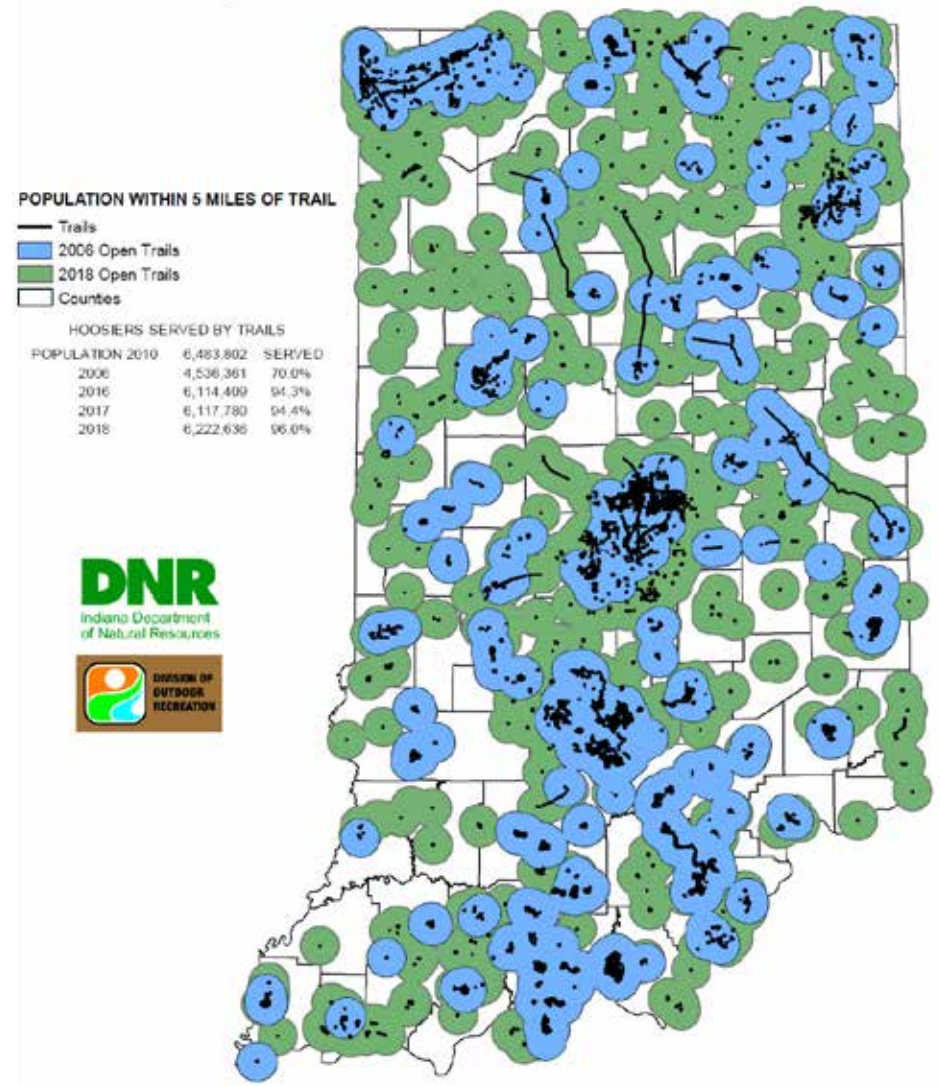
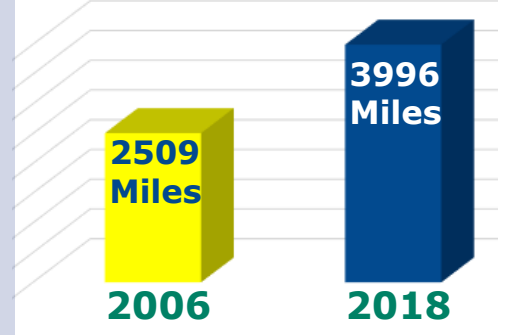

- Assisting in forming effective local trails organizations
 - Building initial community support for trails
 - Providing startup grants to help local trails organizations build capacity and support
 - Acting as a source of trails information and consultation to local Indiana governments
 - Promoting best practices in the planning, marketing, design, development, and management of linear parks

We promote all types of trails, whether they are for bikers, walkers, horseback riders, ATVs or paddling canoes and kayaks down the waterways. We are proud of the many partners and friends we have made along the way!

The Greenways Foundation, Inc. is an Indiana nonprofit corporation, classified as a 501(c)(3) public charitable trust under IRS regulations. This means that contributions can be charitable tax deductions to qualified individuals who itemize deductions on their federal income tax return.

2020 Highlights

The Greenways Foundation helped form the very first **Legislative Trails Caucus** for Indiana. This bi-cameral, bi-partisan group will work together to advance trail development and maintenance in the Hoosier state. As of the end of 2020, 35 legislators, from both chambers, have signed up to be part of the caucus.

Our **state license plate** accounts for our main source of revenue. In 2020 supporters purchased **1838 plates**, resulting in **\$48,225** of income. Those who buy plates become new members of the Foundation.



Thanks to our state plates, we were able to **award \$37,898 in grants** to these six organizations in 2020...

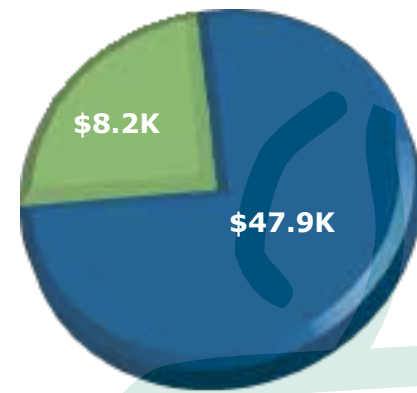
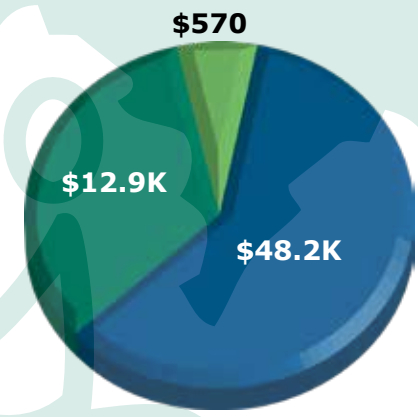

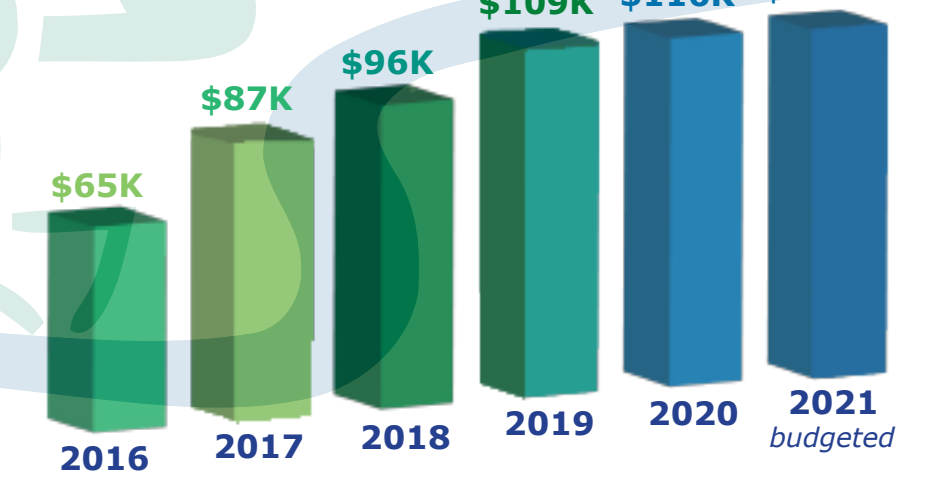
